Subject Preparation for Reopening of Schools during the COVID 19
To Licensees of International Schools
Attachment Measures to be in place for teaching and learning during COVID 19 in Private International Schools

This letter is in accordance to the MOE announcement issued 9 April 2020 stating that all public and private schools under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Education, offering formal or non-formal education, shall open as of July 1, 2020.

The Office of the Private Education Commission has now put forth a proposal to the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) to seek relief for International Schools to reopen on June 1, 2020. Therefore, the OPEC is now requesting that schools prepare for reopening by following the measures for prevention of the contagion of COVID 19, details as per attachment.

The approval to open schools shall be in accordance to the announcement by the CCSA and MOE; and should it be found that if any school does not comply with the precautionary measures as stated, that school shall be ordered to close immediately.

Therefore, please prepare for reopening with full compliance.
